INFORMATION ABOUT 2023/2024 SEASON

The Plainsmen are getting ready for another exciting hockey season. We would love to have your family be a part of this program. Below is some information you may want to know as your make your decision to join us.

- Season -- Our hockey season begins with practice in September and runs through February, ending with our March Meltdown tournament.
- Practices -- Each team will practice twice/week. While the practice schedule may change for the upcoming season, 8U-12U generally practice on Monday and Wednesday evenings, while 14U-18U practice on Tuesday and Thursday evenings.
- Games -- During the course of the season, teams will typically play one or two games each weekend. Home games will be at Ebersole. Away games may be in Westchester County, Putnam County, New York City, New Jersey, and Connecticut. We are part of the Hudson Valley Hockey League and compete with other teams in the league toward playoffs and championships. We will also play non-league games.
- Fees -- In addition to the registration fee to the City of White Plains, each Plainsmen is assessed an annual fee (\$400-\$500), which covers the following costs:
 - Ice fees and coaching at all practices and games from September through March, including early ice at rinks other than Ebersole.
 - Erik Nates instructional practices throughout the season.
 - Practice jerseys
 - Clinics and scholarship for goalies
 - Fees for one tournament (Jamborees for 8U) -- other tournaments will be at the cost of the team.
 - Participation in White Plains March Meltdown Tournament
- Conduct -- The Plainsmen Hockey Club prides itself on a high level of competition. Our teams are consistently winner or runners-up at several divisions in our league and routinely win tournaments. Our greater commitment is to the safety and experience of all of our children. Conduct that is not in line with the Plainsmen Code of Ethics will not be tolerated, may result in reduced playing, suspension, or removal from the team.
